## Working with other local authorities and government agencies

Working with other local authorities and government agencies is a requirement of the Duty to Cooperate. The Duty to Cooperate is a legal requirement which necessitates Croydon Council to engage constructively, actively and an on-going basis with other local authorities, government agencies and public bodies. The Council works with other local authorities on matters related to the preparation of development plans (both Croydon's and other local authorities) and to ensure that the Croydon Local Plan is aligned with the strategic objectives of government agencies and public bodies. Croydon Council must demonstrate that it has complied with the duty at the examination of the Croydon Local Plan: Detailed Policies and Proposals. The table below sets out the occasions since the publication of the last monitoring report when the Council has met with other local authorities, government agencies and public bodies on matters related to the preparation of development plans.
