LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON POLLING DISTRICT REVIEW 2014/15 FINAL REPORT OF THE ACTING RETURNING OFFICER

January 2015

Background and Methodology:

This report sets out for consideration by the Council the Acting Returning Officer's arrangements for polling districts and polling places within the London Borough of Croydon.

The review has been conducted according to the requirements of the Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary elections) Regulations 2006 that came into force on 1st January 2007.

The consultation period lasted from 31 October 2014 to 28 November 2014. All submissions were considered and appear in this final report. The Electoral Working Group, consisting of six members of the Council, considered and reviewed the Acting Returning Officer's proposals.

The methodology followed in producing the proposals was as follows:

- That the Acting Returning Officer's median figure for the initial review of 1,750 projected polling station voters per polling district formed the basis of the recommendations within this report
- That, in line with Electoral Commission guidelines, there will no more than 2,500 electors allocated to each polling station
- That electors will be distributed equally amongst all polling districts in the Ward, where practicable
- That accessibility requirements will be accounted for when allocating polling places
- That local disability groups will be consulted as part of the review
- Polling district boundaries could be changed but not the Ward boundaries

Other considerations:

- There are many new developments in the process of being built. Those completed and occupied prior to the May 2015 General Election were taken into account as part of the review
- New properties that have yet to be completed or occupied will not be considered until after the May 2016 elections where the Wards affected will be reviewed again
- The current electoral register is being used to provide statistics for the review
- The electorate figures will be refreshed during the 2014 annual canvass

Contents of the Report

The report examines each Ward within the London Borough of Croydon in turn, listing the changes to the polling districts, the numbers of voters in each polling district and the polling places as proposed by the Acting Returning Officer. Submissions received during the consultation period are also included.

FA1- The Acting Returning Officer notes the proposed building of 1,800 dwellings within the polling district over the next two years. Electorate figures will need to be reviewed regularly with the possibility to create a double polling station at St Michael's Church

FA2- The Acting Returning Officer notes the proposed building of over 420 dwellings within the polling district over the next two years. No proposed changes as polling station electorate should still be under 2,500, electoral commission threshold.

John Cartwright: elector: That electors in Tidenham Gardens, Bardsley Close, Chepstow Rise, Fleetwood Close and St Arvan's Close (in that order of preference) be transferred to FA6 to reduce the travelling time electors from that area need to walk to access their polling station and to even up the elector numbers at FA5 to bring it more in line with the remaining polling districts in the Ward.

The Electoral Working Group considered the proposal which would result in 380 electors moving from polling district FA5 to FA6. For the purposes of the Electoral Commission guidelines on the number of electors per polling station, the Acting Returning Officer must have regard to the number of electors for that polling station, excluding those electors who have postal votes. Accordingly for these purposes the number of polling station voters at FA5 polling station and FA6 polling station is 1661 and 1911 respectively which fall either side of the median figure of 1,750 projected polling station voters per polling district.

Moving the 5 streets Tidenham Gardens, Bardsley Close, Chepstow Rise, Fleetwood Close and St Arvan's Close from FA5 to FA6 would result in a move of 380 voters from one polling district to another. Of those, 56 voters are postal voters.

The Electoral Working group were mindful of the fact that the initial recommendations of the Acting Returning Officer were for there to be no polling district changes and that the consultation took place on that basis however the representations have duly been taken into account.

Acting Returning Officer's response: Electors from Tidenham Gardens, Bardsley Close, Chepstow Rise, Fleetwood Close and St Arvan's Close will be moved from Polling District FA5 to Polling District FA6.
