The National Oversight Group

- A primary care co-commissioning programme oversight group has been established to take the co-commissioning agenda forward.
- This group is co-chaired by the National Director for Commissioning Strategy, Ian Dodge, and Chief Clinical Officer for NHS Blackpool CCG, Dr Amanda Doyle.
- Membership comprises of CCGs and NHS England.
- This group is responsible for overseeing the development of the co-commissioning policy.
