
### 1. Detailed Considerations

- 1.5 Would the Committee please note that although the applicant has applied for the display of tables and chairs outside the full length of no's 80-88, the current display is outside no 80 only.
- 1.6 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until 21.1.2013 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix B5.
- 1.7 If the street designation order and street trading licence are granted, the applicant will provide a barrier around the tables and chairs in accordance with condition 6 on the temporary licence.
- 1.8 There is no other nearby premises in High Street who currently hold street trading licences. The site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix B6.
- 1.9 If the application for a street trading licence is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year.




PROPOSED GROUND FLOOR PLAN



## Non Transport for London Maintained Roads
