

## **APPENDIX B**

**Applicant:** Navin Kumar Lund

**Location:** On the footway outside 223-225 Lower Addiscombe Road  
Croydon CR0 6RB

**Measurements:** The measurement from the shop window to the edge of the pavement is 3 m..  
The applicant has applied for a trading area of left hand side of the entrance door 0.7 m narrowing to 0.4 m at the bus stop. This leaves a clear pavement width of 2.3 m narrowing to 2m at the bus stop.  
Right hand side of the entrance door trading area of 0.7 m, this leaves a clear pavement width of 2.3 m  
Lower Addiscombe Road is maintained by Croydon Council and the minimum clear pavement width required is 2 m.  
A total display length of 4.7 m and height of 2.5 m are also applied for.

### **1. Detailed Considerations**

- 1.1 The application was received by the Development & Environment Department on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2015.  
A copy of the application is attached as Appendix B4.
- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, no objections were received.
- 1.3 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways, and parking services divisions were invited to comment on this application, no objections have been received.
- 1.4 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.
- 1.5 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until the 1.11.2015 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix B5..

- 1.6 There is 1 other nearby premises in Lower Addiscombe Road who currently holds a street trading licence no 227, tables and chairs This site is marked with a \* and the site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix B6
- 1.7 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year
