A35/15 LICENSING ACT 2003 – APPLICATION FOR A SUMMARY LICENCE REVIEW – APATURA, 14 SOUTH END, CROYDON CR0 1DL

In respect of Apatura, 14 South End, Croydon CR0 1DL, the Licensing Sub-Committee considered information circulated by the Licensing Manager including:

- A copy of the application including a copy of the relevant certificate signed by a Police Chief Superintendent
- A copy of the premises licence for the premises licence holder Conchitas Ltd
- A copy of a Home Office guidance document on summary reviews.

The Council, as licensing authority, has to determine a review of the premises licence within 28 days of the application being made. On receipt of the application however the licensing Sub-Committee has 48 hours to decide whether to take any interim steps pending the full review hearing.

The options open to the Licensing Sub-Committee include:

- Modification of the conditions of the premises licence
- The exclusion of the sale by retail of alcohol from the scope of the licence
- Removal of the designated premises supervisor from the licence
- Suspension of the licence

The Licensing Sub-Committee, having considered the information provided **RESOLVED** to suspend the licence.
