1. Detailed Considerations

1.1 The application was received by the Place Department on 14 July 2015.

A copy of the application is attached as Appendix C4...

- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, no objections were received.
- 1.3 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways, and parking services divisions were invited to comment on this application.
- 1.4 Objections were received on the application from the Licensing Police, Capital

Delivery Hub and Hammerson plc , copies of these are attached as Appendix C5.

- 1.5 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.
- 1.6 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which was valid until the 14.1.2016 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix C6.

Following the concerns raised by the licensing police in their objection the

temporary licence has subsequently been withdrawn.

- 1.7 There are 2 other nearby premises in George Street who also display tables and chairs no's 91- 93, Café Nero and 95, Pret a Manger who both have a private forecourt measuring 3.5 m out from the shop window. A street trading licence is not required for displays on a private forecourt. These sites are marked with a * and the site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix C7.
- 1.8 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year
