

APPENDIX B

Applicant: Mr Gazmir Metushi

Location: On the footway outside 256 High Street Croydon Surrey
CR0 1NF

Measurements: The applicant has applied for 2 display areas.
West Street – Width 0.5 m , length 0.5m , height 1.2 m for 1 planter
High St – Width 1.3 and length 4.6 m for tables and chairs. These measurements include room for staff to move freely inside a barrier which the applicant will provide to enclose the tables and chairs should the designation be granted.

This leaves a clear pavement width of 2.1 m on High Street and 2.9 m on West Street
High Street and West St are maintained by Croydon Council and the minimum required clear pavement width is 2 m.

Appendices B2 and B3 are photographs of the display.

Monday to Friday 1200 hours (noon) until 2300 hours
Saturday 1130 hours until 2300 hours
Sunday 1130 hours until 2200 hours

To Display: Tables and Chairs and 1 Planter

1. Detailed Considerations

- 1.1 The application was received by the Place Department on 12 September 2016.
A copy of the application is attached as Appendix B4.
- 1.2 The application was duly advertised in the Croydon Guardian, no objections were received.
- 1.3 The Police licensing Officers, Food Safety team, Planning, Highways , and parking services divisions were invited to comment on this application, no objections have been received.
- 1.4 The measurements outlined above have been checked and agreed by an Enforcement Officer during a site visit.
- 1.5 A temporary licence was issued to the applicant which is valid until the 12.3.2017 pending the committee's decision. A copy is attached as Appendix B5.

- 1.6 There is 1 other nearby premises who currently holds a street trading licences, no 282 – tables and chairs. This site is marked with an x and the site applied for is shaded on the attached map Appendix B6
- 1.7 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will provide a barrier around the tables and chairs in accordance with condition 6 on the temporary licence
- 1.8 If the application for a street designation order is granted the applicant will be invited to apply for a Street Trading Licence which will then be valid for a year
