
Objection Notice - The Prevention of Public Nuisance

I am satisfied that allowing the premises known as 58-60 Windmill Road, Croydon, CR0 2XP to be used for an event on the 31st December 2016 in conjunction with the Temporary Event Notice received by the Pollution Team on 5th December 2016, would undermine the Prevention of Public Nuisance Licensing Objective for the following reasons:

- Since February 2016, the Pollution team has received several complaints about noise from this premises.
- On 8th October 2016 a Pollution Enforcement Officer witnessed Noise at a level that was considered a Statutory Nuisance from the premises concerned whilst the officer was in a neighbouring premises. The officer proceeded to serve a statutory abatement notice on the Occupier of 58 -60 Windmill road.
- The applicant has not informed the councils Pollution team of any measures
 that have been put in place to mitigate the noise nuisance caused to
 neighbouring residents when events are held at this premises in order to
 comply with the prevention of Public Nuisance licensing objective.
- We are aware that the applicant does not have planning permission to hold events after 20.00hrs at this location. This venue is not suitable for events of this nature as residents in the vicinity would be likely to suffer noise nuisance.

The Croydon Council Pollution Team is hereby putting in this objection notice in order to protect residents from suffering noise nuisance as intended under the Prevention of Public Nuisance licensing objective.
