Decision Title: CONTRACT AWARD ADULT AND YOUNG PEOPLE SOCIAL CARE DYNAMIC PURCHASING SYSTEMS (DPS) 3 – LOT 1 - SUPPORTED LIVING

Details of decision:

Having carefully read and considered the Part A report, the associated confidential part B report, and the requirements of the Council's public sector duty in relation to the issues detailed in the body of the reports, the Cabinet Member for Families, Health & Social Care in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Finance & Resources

RESOLVED: To approve

1. The establishment of, and initial appointment of suppliers listed in the Part B report to, DPS 3 Lot 1 (Supported Living) of the Adult and Young People Social Care DPS for a period of five years with an extension option for five subsequent periods each of one year. This is based on the contract terms

issued as part of inviting tenders, such suppliers being those who have satisfied specified selection criteria;

2. Delegation of the award of contracts and placements called off under DPS 3 Lot 1 to be approved in accordance with the Council's Scheme of Financial Delegations and notified to Cabinet in accordance with paragraph 2.4 of the report; and
3. Delegation of the future appointment of providers to DPS 3 Lot 1 (and to the previously established DPS 3 Lot 2) to be approved by the Executive Director of Health, Well Being and Adults in accordance with paragraph 2.4 of the report.
