

## Supplementary Statement to Croydon Health and Wellbeing Board's Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment

Date Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment published – November 2022

Date Supplementary Statement issued – [Month 2023]

The Regulations state that Supplementary Statements can provide updates to the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment only in relation to changes in the availability of pharmaceutical services. Supplementary Statements cannot provide updates on pharmaceutical need: this can only be achieved through a review of the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment.
