

Objection to a TEN,

Objection Notice - The Prevention of Crime and Disorder, The protection of children, Public safety and the prevention of public nuisance.

Proposed event date 26th to 31st December 2017. (Until midnight hours).

I am satisfied that allowing the premises at to be used in accordance with the Temporary Event Notice received by Croydon Police on the 08/12/2017 from Mr M. Mankarious of Fixed Restaurant, units 28 – 29 Boxpark, 99 George Street, Croydon, CT0 1LD. would undermine the Licensing Objectives as above for the following reason:

- The Police have not been given advance notice of this event as recommended in the Croydon Council Licensing Policy and the Statutory Guidance to the Licensing Act 2003. In order that the risk may be assessed. The applicant has not discussed the application for licensable activity prior to submission of the notification with police.
- The applicant has not informed police how the premises will be managed in support of the licensing objectives, in relation to Protection of children, prevention of crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance.
- The venue is part of a larger complex which does not allow trade past 2300 hours this may be a breach of tenancy agreement. This does not concern police directly but raises issues such as security, access and public safety.
- The applicant has stated on the notice that 175 people are expected and has not explained the logistics, as the premises itself is not able to hold 175 people.

- The original set up of the overall premises was configured to only have one closely supervised bar other operators are restricted to alcohol sales ancillary to a table meals. Police consider that variation from this may increase the risk of drunkenness and disorder.
- The overall venue has recently been the subject of serious violent disorder and again the police are against any variation to the normal operations as this would increase the risk of disorder.
- The operator of this venue has been spoken to by police on more than one occasion re the sale of alcohol not related to meals. He has not taken police advice. This application is in direct opposition to police advice.

I am satisfied that the granting of this Temporary Event Notice would undermine the licensing objectives and would have a negative impact on the overall venue and the local community.

The view of the Metropolitan Police regarding the sale by retail of alcohol, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment if authorised for this premises is that they would be associated with an UNKNOWN RISK OF CRIME AND DISORDER.

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

This licence is granted subject to the terms of the Licensing Act 2003

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. (1) The responsible person shall ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises—
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
 - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
4. The responsible person shall ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
5. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
 (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request,

before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—

- (a) a holographic mark, or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature.

6. The responsible person must ensure that—

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.”

***Responsible person is defined as:**

(a) In relation to licensed premises:

- (i) The holder of a premises licence in respect of the premises,
- (ii) The designated premises supervisor (if any) under such a licence, or
- (iii) Any individual aged 18 or over who is authorised for the purposes of section 153 (4) of the Licensing Act 2003 by such a holder or supervisor,

(b) In relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables him to prevent the supply in question

In respect of the condition governing age verification, there are specific duties relating respectively to the holder of the premises licence or club premises certificate and designated premises supervisor.

7. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

For the purposes of the condition set out in the above paragraph

(a) “duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979

(b) “permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula—

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where —

(i) P is the permitted price,

- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
