**Re: Alcohol License for The Warehouse, 12 Central Parade
In the name of Reshma Talwar**

I strongly object to this application for the following reasons:

1. There is a CIZ (Cumulative Impact Zone) in place due to the numerous existing alcohol outlets along Central Parade.
2. Most of the existing outlets already sell alcohol from early in the morning (6am) until at least 10pm every evening.
3. I believe this gentleman is linked to another shop keeper who already operates 3 of these such shops along Central Parade.
4. Since the Dispersal Zones have been removed, I believe yet another alcohol outlet will un-necessarily create further anti-social issues and Met Police figures show the rate of ASB is already highest around the Central Parade area now.
5. Residents in their homes above the shops already cope with enough anti-social behaviour including individuals urinating and defecating in the stairwells, another alcohol outlet will more than likely add to their stress.
